Quick Start Guide

Prerequisites

You will need a ColorWorks printer (C4000, C6000 or C6500 series) and a Windows PC.



1 Install ColorWorks Printer Driver

Set up your ColorWorks printer and install the corresponding ColorWorks driver. See "start here" guide included with printer for additional guidance.

2 Install and activate Label Boost software

Label Boost software can be downloaded from https://epson.com/LabelBoostDownload. After installing Label Boost, use your license key provided by email to activate.


- 3 Set up print job routing
 - a) Shipping Software → Label Boost

Open the software you are using to print your original shipping labels. Access the printer selection settings and change the printer to the one shown below, so that print jobs are routed to Label Boost.



b) Label Boost → ColorWorks

Go back to Label Boost and open "printer settings" from the File menu. Select your ColorWorks printer and applicable label size that your final label will be.






Start "boosting" your labels!

Label Boost allows you to define conditions based on date, location or text, and then choose which label enhancement actions to apply based on those conditions.

Click "Add New" and create a condition and action. An example is shown below which will always add a "Fragile" image (selected from the included image library).

Finish by clicking "Apply Changes".





From your shipping software, print a test label. Your new enhanced label should print on the ColorWorks printer. If not, review the steps above or view our support materials linked at the end of this guide for troubleshooting tips.
